Dear Parents/Carers of Y5/6

As of next Tuesday, 10th September, Year 5/6 will have a weekly swimming session at Christleton High School, with the last one being on Tuesday, 17th December. Our sessions will be 2.00-2.30pm. Miss. Jones, Mrs. Thompson and Mr. Allman will be attending with the children. We are going to use the school mini-bus and staff cars to transport the children. The Swimming Teacher (employed by Brio) has sent the following requests:

Please ensure:

- Swimmers are appropriately dressed. Girls must wear a full swimming costume (no bikinis/tankinis). Boys need tight fitting swimming shorts, above the knee (no baggy/surf shorts as these make it harder to swim).
- No jewellery is worn. (If jewellery cannot be removed for religious reasons it should be secured by tape, plasters or a sweat band placed over the top.)
- Long hair is tied back or secured in a hat.
- If children need goggles, for medical or associated reasons, that they meet British Standard BS5883.

We are asking for a £5.00 voluntary contribution per child towards transport. Children may bring a healthy snack with them for after swimming: fruit, cereal bar, a healthy sandwich, water (not crisps/biscuits). Please complete the form below and return it to school by Monday, 9th September. Please reassure any children who are worried about swimming that they will only have to do what they are comfortable doing- they will not be forced into the pool!
