The day will consist of a tour of the museum with a specific look at the Bronze, Stone and Iron Age exhibitions as well as participating in related workshops led by the museum team. The cost of the visit is £8.00.

We suggest that the children wear warm trousers (they don't have to be school uniform), a warm waterproof coat and sensible shoes for walking. For easy identification inside the museum, the children should wear their school polo shirt and school jumper/cardigan. The children will also need a small, labelled backpack into which they can put their lunch, snacks and water bottle.
