On Monday 11th and Tuesday 12th November, Year 1 and 2 will be undertaking a two-day Design and Technology project. For these two days, please send your child into school wearing clothes that you don't mind getting messy.

This project will be looking at designing a suitable treasure chest for a pirate captain where the children will work through three key Design and Technology principles: design, make and evaluate.

To support this, we are asking parents to please provide materials that could be used for junk modelling so that the children can create a prototype of their designs. Materials could include: empty cereal boxes, empty tissue boxes, empty milk bottles (plastic), empty washing up bottles, etc. We do ask that if you are sending in plastic bottles/food containers that they are washed prior to being sent into school to reduce the risk of allergic reactions.
