Recycling is an essential part of our daily lives and the curriculum. On Tuesday 19th November 2019, we have the exciting opportunity to visit a state of the art B&M Recycling Education Centre in Birkenhead, to learn all about how we can reduce, reuse and recycle!

We will be learning about the B&M Waste's Litter Pickers Programme. This is fun and interactive and encourages children to develop an understanding of ways that we can reduce, reuse and recycle our waste, and the wider environmental impact our actions today will have for decades to come. The session covers the national curriculum, including Maths, Science, English and Citizenship as well as moral, ethical and social awareness and responsibility. The trip will be taking place mostly indoors so the children need to be **in their school uniform top with warm bottoms (can be casual not school uniform) and a coat**. The children will also need a small, labelled backpack into which they can put their lunch, snacks and water bottle. There is **no gift shop** at the centre so the children will not need to bring spending money.

We need to arrive at the centre for 10am and will be back at school for normal home time at 3:30pm.
