Dear Parents/Carers of Year 6

As we move towards our last week with our current Year 6 we would like to confirm what activities we are able to offer safely, due to Covid-19.

Having taken local and national guidance into account, we are delighted to announce that our Year 6 children will have the opportunity to host a Leavers' Service on the school field. We are currently planning for this to take place on Thursday, 23rd July, at 1.00pm and 2.15pm. To ensure that no more than 6 family bubbles attend at either service, we ask that you contact the School Office via email to confirm which time your family would prefer to attend. Places will be offered on a first come, first served basis. To limit the number of people at the event, we are also limiting each family to sending 2 members of their family bubble. If you would like to film all or part of the service, to share with other family members, please let the School Office know when you request your place. We will mark out family bubbles 2m apart around the field for families to gather and provide chairs, which will be cleaned between the services. If you would like to bring your own gazebo to set up in advance, please phone or email Mrs. Wright so that we can arrange access to the field. The children will have shelter under the school gazebos if necessary, but we are hoping for a bit of sunshine!

We are also planning to hold a Y5/6 Sports Day event during the school day on Monday subject to dry weather. Unfortunately parents will not be able to attend due to larger numbers of children participating. We will upload photographs to Facebook for those children for whom we have permission to do so.

As we have had to put our Leavers' Night on hold, Miss. Jones would like to hold a Leavers' Picnic for her class on the field on Friday, 24th July (12:30pm onwards). Again, this is a child only event and is weather dependent, so we will confirm the night before.

For the picnic children will need to bring the following:

- A packed lunch in a disposable bag.
- Water bottle filled with juice or water.
- Picnic blanket or camping chair, so they can sit comfortably.

Children can bring sweets and chocolate if you wish but unfortunately they cannot share the sweets or chocolate with other pupils in their class. It will be a day that the children can enjoy, playing games and having some time with their peers before they leave Utkinton St Paul's. This will be a pupil only event.

Finally, if the Year 6 pupils would like to wear their Utkinton school uniform, for the last time, on Friday, they are more than welcome to do so.
