Thank you for the help you are giving your children with their science learning, it is appreciated in these challenging times. I wanted to let you know that I have arranged a very exciting virtual live science lesson for them next week with a STEM Ambassador. STEM Ambassadors are volunteers from a wide range of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) related jobs and disciplines across the UK. They offer their time and enthusiasm to help bring STEM subjects to life and demonstrate the value of them in life and careers.

Our STEM Ambassador will be Dr Lilah Glazer, she is currently a lecturer in Biomedical Sciences at Queen Mary University, London. The content will be focused on animal behaviour and will include a presentation, video and an opportunity for an interactive question and answer session. I will be there virtually with the children for both sessions. They will take place for each class during our usual live science slots as below but might be a bit longer than usual, so I have allowed up to 45 minutes:

Years 5 and 6 – Monday 8th February, 2.10-2.55pm

Years 3 and 4 – Tuesday 9th February, 9.15-10.00am
