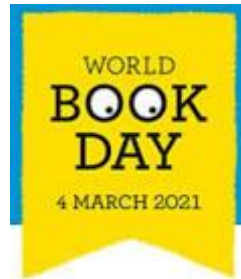

Dear Parents/Carers

On Thursday, 04th March 2021, we will be holding a virtual World Book Day. The theme for our World Book Day this year will be 'Abracadabra!' Pupils are invited to attend school, or their live lessons, dressed as a magical character from a children's book. Unless it was a book, prior to being made into a film, we ask that pupils base their outfit on a book character. Some of the children's books that link with this theme are 'Harry Potter', 'The Hobbit', 'The BFG', 'Chronicles of Narnia', 'The Enchanted Wood', 'Winne the Witch', 'How to Catch a Unicorn' and 'Room on the Broom'. School staff will also be joining in with the dressing up!

The day will focus on celebrating reading and books. Teachers will set activities linked to World Book Day for pupils to complete at home or in school. The live meets will still go ahead, but they will be linked to World Book Day:

- The first live session will involve the class teacher sharing and reading their favourite book to their class. They will also explain what activities there are for children to complete during the day.
- The second live session will be an opportunity for the children to share what activities they have completed at home or their favourite books they have read or been reading.
